# **Investing in research: An action plan for Europe**

***Strengthening the human resources in research thus involves a combination of initiatives at national, regional and Community levels aiming at:***

- Attracting more students to research, in particular through the increase in the national and Community financial incentives, the Science and Society initiatives, especially the "Women and science" action plan and the facilitation of the students' mobility;***



# Investing in research: An action plan for Europe

- *Attracting international researchers in Europe and fostering mobility between academia and industry;*
- *Maintaining the researchers in the profession and in the European Research Area by giving favourable career development prospects and a positive image of the researcher's profession".*

## **Condition of admission of Third Country Researchers in Europe:**

- ❖ Member States in collaboration with the Commission are invited to strengthen the actions being undertaken to develop the ERA, in particular by facilitating or continuing to facilitate entry and residence for researchers from third countries.**
